CRITERIA

This scholarship competition is open to all students currently studying with a MB NATS member in good standing.

Repertoire:

***** All repertoire must be composed from 1970 onward. *****

Intermediate Level competitors must present two contrasting songs composed from 1970 onward, memorized, one of which must be by a Canadian composer (no folksong arrangements).

Senior Level competitors must present two pieces composed from 1970 onward including one English art song and one aria or foreign language art song. One of the two pieces must be Canadian.

Advanced I & II Level competitors must present three pieces, including one English art song, one foreign language art song, and one aria. Two of the three pieces must be composed from 1970 onward, one of which must be Canadian.

Repertoire will be at the following equivalency or higher according to Royal Conservatory of Music standards: Intermediate: Grade 6-7; Senior: Grade 8-9; Advanced I & II: Grade 10+. Adjudicators will take into consideration the degree of difficulty of the repertoire when marking.

Original Copies: Include with your video submissions either photos of performer holding 1 original copy of each piece performed. Proof of purchase for all downloaded scores should also be visible. Displaying this at the beginning of your video submission is also acceptable.

Performers will provide their own collaborative pianists at their own expense. Accompanists playing live on recordings must use original scores. Accompaniment tracks from reputable sources will be allowed as outlined in the following NATS competition regulations: [https://www.nats.org/NSA -
